Art. 1

Subject matter of a contract

1. Subject matter of the contract is to provide an internship for the participants in the project **Cestujeme za gastronomickými a kulturnými zážitkami** (We travel for gastronomic and cultural experiences) within the Erasmus+ program.
2. The receiving organisation will allow 8 project participants to complete an online internship and contract facilities from 06.05.2021 to 22.06.2021, included.
3. Both contracting parties confirm to follow the conditions which were signed by the receiver in a contract with the National agency.

Art. 2
Obligations of the sending organisation

1. The sending org. also observes the mobility, objective progress to the goals. Monitoring forms:
 - phone and e-mail contact with the internship participants
 - getting feedback from mentors and internship participants
 - getting information about adherence to the time schedule for project
2. Creates/Makes EUROPASS MOBILITY and ECVET documents based on participant activity realisation during mobility.
3. Provides didactic equipment, classrooms, using of the Internet, or other tools needed for the online internship.
4. Collaborates with partners and participants on project evaluation and results dissemination.
5. Coordinates partner and participant activity during mobility.
6. Elaborates a final report.

Art. 3
Obligations of receiving organisation

1. Provides material, technical and organisational conditions for online participation.
2. Collaborates during monitoring of the mobility, fulfilling of the objectives, tasks assignments, participants monitoring, feedback.
3. Elaborates ECVET, internship certificate.
4. Provides instructional videos for online practice.
5. Collaboration with project coordinator during mobility progress observation, objective fulfilment.
6. Collaborates with the project coordinator and other project partner on project evaluation and results dissemination.
7. Respects commitment of quality.

Art. 4
Budget

1. All financial adjustments will be realised in EUR (currency), with exchange rate valid on the day of invoicing being on all financial documents.
2. Covered student expenses within the internship:

- creating instructional videos
3. Form of expense cover in art. 4, points 2, 3,4 is according to Slovak laws. The receiving organisation will present a complete and accurate list of expenses for each participant after the internship. A proof of delivery will be attached to the invoice. Payment will be realised to the receiving organisation's account, with due date of 14 days from its consent.

Art. 5
Final statement/assignment

4. This contract gains validity and effect with both contracting parties' signature, and is concluded for a definite period **during the time of the project**.
5. The contract can be changed only after an agreement, in form of written amendments signed by both contracting parties. Context strictly not modified by this contract are administrated by appropriate constitution of Commercial code, and Civil code.
6. Official language is English.
7. During the realisation of participant mobility, communication will be provided via project coordinator, guide, who which will be available during the whole internship.
8. Contracting parties are obliged to adequately respond to any controversy resulting from the contract with correlative proceedings.
9. Contract is completed in two counterparts, one for each of the contracting parties.
10. Both contracting parties declare, that they carefully read the contract constitution, understood the content, and declare, that the contract was not forced, nor sealed due to any inadequate conditions, and signed as a sign of approval.
